

# Non-Mains Energy Concession 2019



## What does the Non-Mains Energy Concession provide?

The annual concession provides eligible cardholders who are not connected to mains gas and/or electricity with a rebate, to help with the costs of other energy sources.

## What types of energy are eligible?

- Liquefied Petroleum Gas (LPG)
- Heating oil
- Firewood, including briquettes (special conditions apply)
- Generator fuel (special conditions apply)
- Non-mains electricity (as part of an embedded network).

## What cards are eligible for the concession?

- Centrelink and Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card
- Centrelink Health Care Card (except Carer Allowance and Foster Care Cards)
- Veterans' Affairs Gold Card.

## When can you apply?

Cardholders can apply for their concession from 1 July 2019. Applications are available from the Concessions Information Line on **1800 658 521** (toll free), or ask your local council, LPG supplier or caravan park proprietor.

## What if I need help now?

If you cannot pay your non-mains energy bill you may be eligible for assistance through the Non-Mains Utility Relief Grant Scheme. Eligibility criteria apply.
